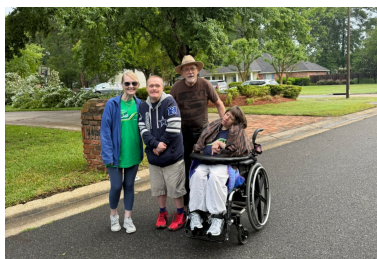
Out and About
